10. Activity Outcomes:

This event was inaugurated on **7th November 2023** in presence of **Dr. Souvik Barat**, Senior Scientist, Tata Consultancy Services Limited, Pune, **Dr. S. B. Sadale** (Director, IPR Cell Shivaji University, Kolhapur). Other dignitaries present on dais were **Prof. (Dr) Uday A. Dabade** (Director, WCE), **Dr. M. A. Shah** (Head CSE and Convenor of RSC 2023), **Dr. R. R. Rathod** (Head IT and Convenor of RSC 2023). They addressed the gathering on expectations of various stake holders from researching students at WCE.

7. Awards were presented to first three best projects and one best poster at the hands of the Judges.
8. Among the research papers presented at RSC2023 a best presentation award was announced and all these awards are sponsored by the Sakal Foundation.

There were Twelve researchers orally presented their research work. Fourteen poster presentations were arranged. Nineteen mini projects were show cased. Eight judges evaluated the all research / poster / mini-projects and adjudged best presentations in each of the presentation categories.

Symposium produced e-proceeding of abstracts of all peer reviewed abstract.

The proceeding also includes abstract of presentations of the key note speakers. The e-proceeding has ISBN. number.

Near about 100 Participants totally actively participated throughout the event.

The volunteers got very good experiences to improve on their soft skills in the organization of the events. Department of CSE and IT received very good credit of organizing the events successfully.
