## A) Regular re-registration for students with FF/XX1/XX2 grades

Students who have obtained FF/XX1/XX2 grade in theory/laboratory/seminar/miniproject course/s of previous year/s are informed that they should complete re-registration process during the above period.

## B) Re-registration for CPI improvement

Student/s of third and final year B. Tech. whose CPI is less than 6.50 (for the students admitted prior to 2014-15)/6.75 (for the students admitted after 2014-15) after 4<sup>th</sup> semester may apply for CPI improvement by re-registeringfor the course/s in which DD/CD grade has been obtained. A student in third year can apply for second year course/s and a student in final year can apply for third year course/s.

Student/s of second year M. Tech. whose CPI is less than 6.75 after 2<sup>nd</sup>semester may apply for CPI improvement by re-registering for the course/s of first year in which DD/CD grade has been obtained.

Student/s who has passed final B. Tech. in 2015-16 and has CPI less than 6.50 may apply for CPI improvement by re-registering for the course/s of final and third year in which the student has obtained CD/DD grade.

Student/s who has passed second year M. Tech. in 2015-16 and has CPI less than 6.75 may apply for CPI improvement by re-registering for the course/s of first year M. Tech. in which the student has obtained CD/DD grade.

Student/s are allowed to re-register for maximum five courses for CPI improvement.

Students not completing the re-registration process as per the above schedule will not be allowed to appear for any component of evaluation (ISE, MSE and ESE) during academic year 2016-17. No re-registration will be allowed after 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2016.
